

Vocera Ease Emergency Room with EMR Integration

Course Description

Vocera Ease is a communication tool used in the Emergency Department to provide manual and automatically triggered updates to patients and selected loved ones from door to discharge. The ideal Ease candidate in the Emergency Room is an ambulatory patient that arrives as a walk-in rather than in an ambulance.

This course will cover how Vocera Ease ER works, how to introduce and register patients into Vocera Ease ER, how to send Vocera Ease ER updates, and information on discharging a patient out of Vocera Ease ER. This training takes approximately 15 minutes to complete.
