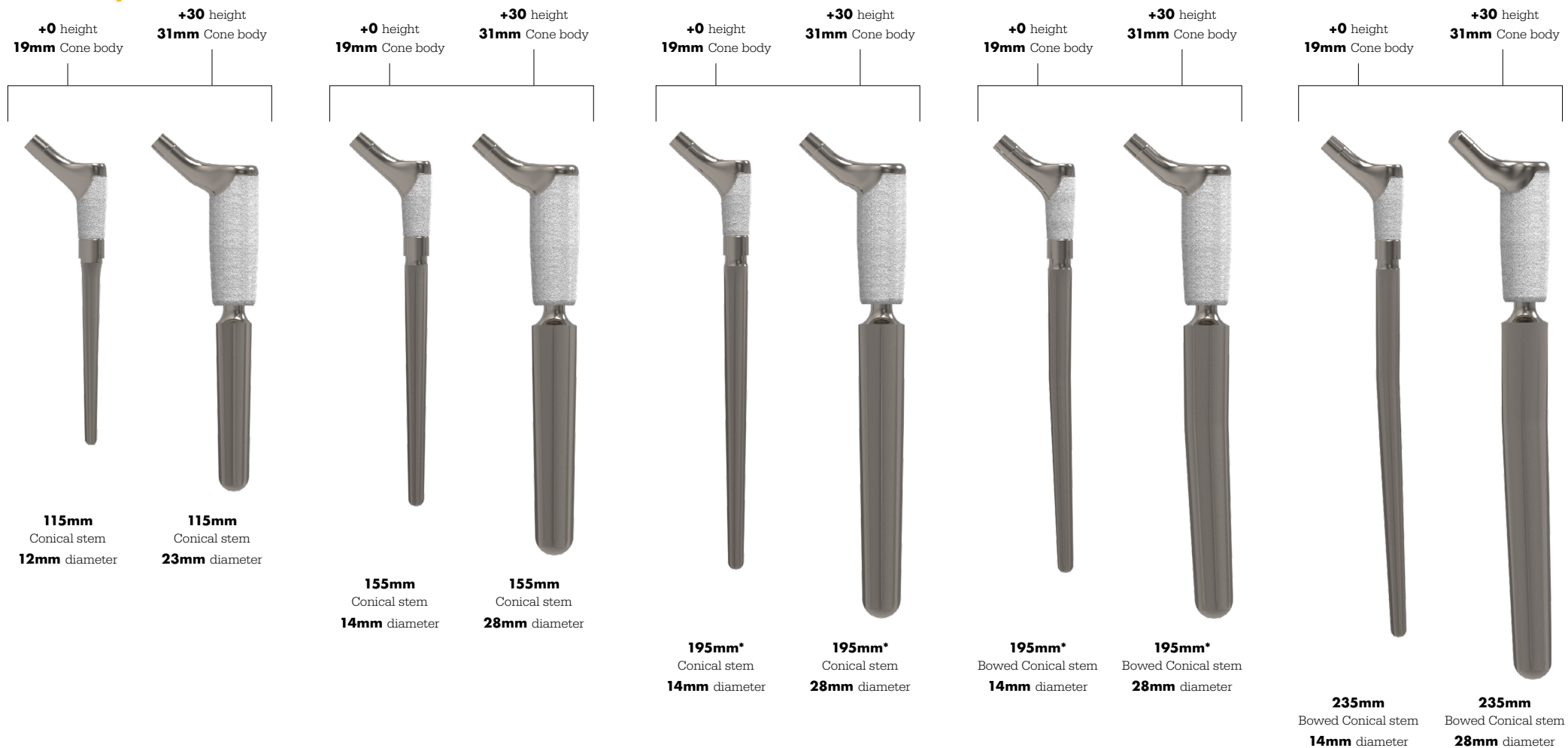

## Cone body and Conical stem

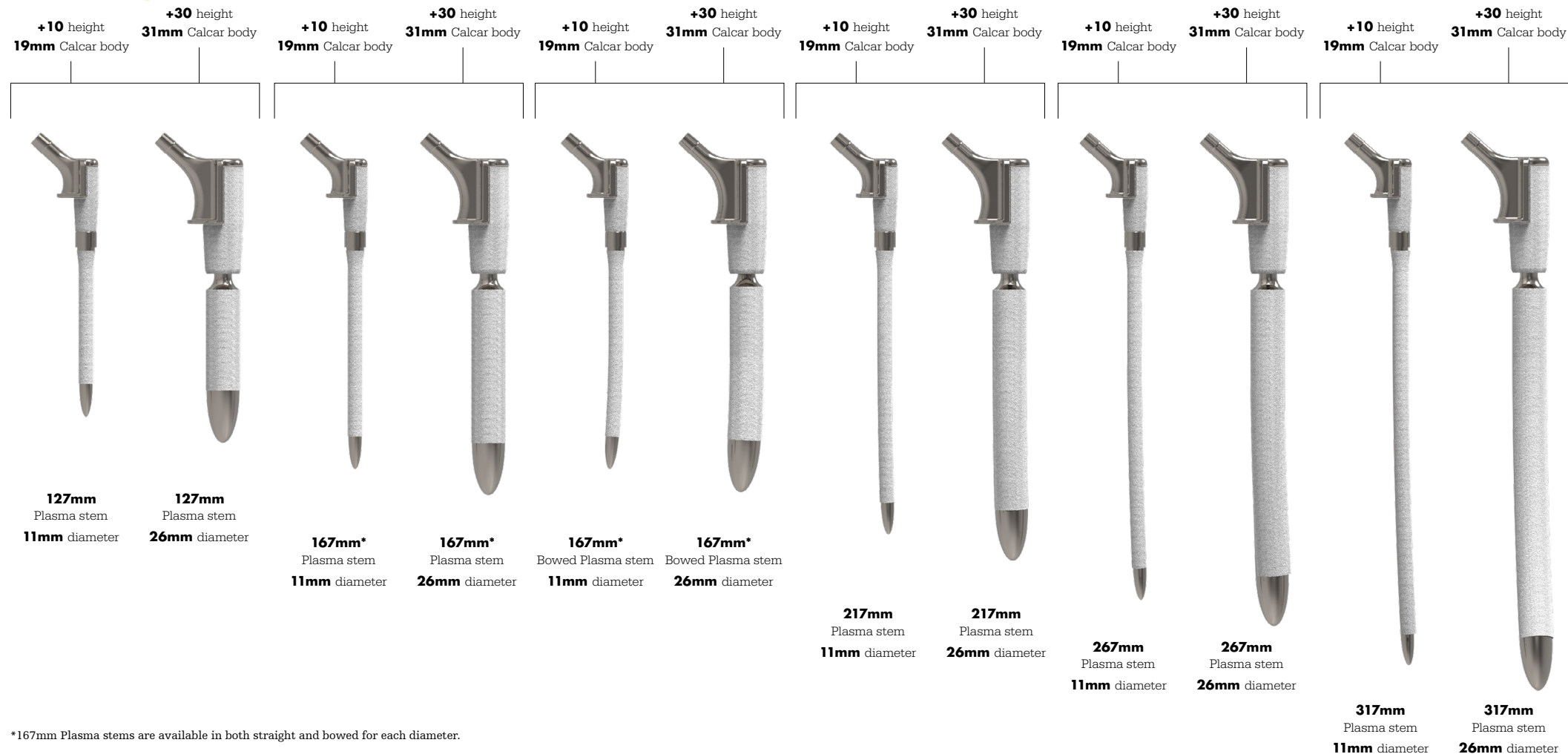
