

# **Hunter** Tendon Implants

# Quick reference guide

#### **Overview**

The Hunter Tendon Implants are indicated for use in stage one of the two-stage procedure for the reconstruction of the flexor and extensor tendons in individuals having significant hand tendon injury.

## Stage 1

Rods are implanted temporarily to replicate the natural tendon allowing a pseudosynovial sheath to form which is intended to laternourish and lubriate an autogenous tendon graft.

# Stage 2

The time between implantation and removal of the device is typically 2 to 6 months to permit maturation of the tendon bed to the point where it can nourish and lubricate a tendon graft. The Palmaris tendon is favored by hand surgeons for the tendon graft. The Plantaris tendon can also be used.
